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**Magnolia Summer Festival Food Booth Application**  
**At Magnolia Playfield and West Smith Street**

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The annual Magnolia Summer Festival for 2010 will be held at Magnolia Playfield at the corner of 32nd and West Smith and on West Smith Street. The fair is an official Seafair event scheduled for August 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> (Friday and Saturday). Activities include entertainment, children's entertainment, craft booths, food booths, the largest children's parade in the state and the annual Magnolia Seafair parade.

The Summer Festival is seeking various food vendors serving quality food products. This fair, while not being among the largest, does offer a clientele interested in quality and originality. Those wishing to participate must return their application with fee no later than May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 to retain their early status.

- Cost:** \$350 for 10' x 10' space (Larger space will be additional)
- Required:** **City of Seattle Business License. If you do not have a City of Seattle Business License a \$5.00 per day charge will be made (\$10.00).**

**Fire Permit** required for use of liquid petroleum gas and open fire (wood/charcoal). Please contact the Seattle Fire Department at (206) 386-1450.

**Food Permit** issued by the Seattle Department of Public Health is required. Please contact the Seattle Department of Public Health, 2124 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Seattle, WA 98121 (206) 296-4632

**Application:** Vendors must submit 1 photo of food and 1 photo/drawing of your booth. Please identify each photo and they will be returned to you during the festival.

**Booth Size:** 10' x 10'. We provide only the space. We do provide a security guard Thursday and Friday night. The Chamber of Commerce and Summer Festival assumes no liability for any vendor property. Locations will be assigned as applications are received and accepted.

**Requirements:** 100 feet of electrical cord (3 prong) if electricity is needed. Also, adequate signage indicating prices for all items.

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**Magnolia Summer Festival Food Booth Application**

The annual Magnolia Summer Festival will be held Friday, August 6<sup>th</sup> and Saturday, August 7<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at the Magnolia Field at West Smith Street.

**Please note, the following must be provided by each food vendor.**

1. A current permit issued by the Seattle Department of Public Health
2. Seattle Fire Department fire permit.
3. If power needed, 100 feet of electrical cord (3 prong)
4. Adequate signage indicating prices for all items.
5. City of Seattle Business License Number. If you do not have a City of Seattle Business License, a \$5 per day fee will be charged (\$10)

**COST:** \$350 for 10' x 10' space rental. If more than 10' x 10' space is required, additional fees will be charged. Food Vendor will be responsible for paying appropriate state and city sales tax. A security guard will be on the premises at night, yet we cannot be held liable for any vendor property.

**MAGNOLIA SUMMER FESTIVAL  
Food Booth Agreement**

Magnolia Chamber of Commerce, hereinafter known as MC<sub>2</sub>, and \_\_\_\_\_, hereinafter known as Vendor, in consideration of their mutual promises set forth herein below, do hereby agree as follows:

1. Vendor shall be permitted to operate a food booth during the Magnolia Summer Festival, August 6<sup>th</sup> & August 7<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at an area at the location of the festival to be designated by MC<sub>2</sub>, the said permission representing a valuable benefit to Vendor. This permission is subject to MC<sub>2</sub>'s right of refusal.
2. Vendor shall pay to MCC at the time of submission of this Application/Agreement:  
Food Booth: **\$350** enclosed and **\$10** in lieu of Seattle Business License.
3. Vendor shall comply with all applicable laws and regulations in connection with the operation of Vendor's business at the Magnolia Summer Festival, including payment of all state and city taxes due from said operation.
4. **Vendor shall have a City of Seattle Business License or pay a \$5.00 per day license fee. Fee of \$10.00 enclosed.**
5. Vendor shall hold MC<sub>2</sub> harmless as to any loss occasioned by anyone due to Vendor's said operation.
6. Vendor should carry liability insurance for their operation.
7. Each food booth application is to be accompanied by one (1) color photo showing representative products and a photo/drawing indicating the appearance of the booth. These photos will be returned upon request during the festival.
8. Vendor shall execute and complete and deliver this Application/Agreement to MC<sub>2</sub> at the address for MC<sub>2</sub> no later than May 1, 2010 for it to be valid and binding upon MC<sub>2</sub>. In the event that MC<sub>2</sub> refuses this Application/Agreement, or if it is withdrawn prior to the Festival, the payment made by Vendor with this Application/Agreement shall be refunded.
